Hanford B Reactor Tours - only 26 seats available

The B Reactor National Historic Landmark at the Hanford Site in Washington state was the world's first full-scale plutonium production reactor. Created as part of the top secret Manhattan Project during World War II, B Reactor produced the plutonium used in the Trinity Test (the world's first nuclear detonation) in July 1945, as well as for the atomic bomb dropped on Nagasaki, Japan in August 1945 that contributed to the Japanese surrender and end of World War II. Tour starts at 11:45 AM and lasts about 4 hours. We will provide transportation to the drop site where you load onto to the tour bus. *We have not determined if we are able to provide a lunch with this tour yet.

Bechtel National Planetarium

The Bechtel National Planetarium at CBC provides life-like, high-definition images and sound using the most state-of-the-art projection system in the Pacific Northwest. The 36-foot panoramic viewing dome can simulate a 3-D effect (without the need for strange glasses)! A typical hour-long show includes a 20-30 minute live presentation and a 25-30 minute full-dome movie. Presentation topics may include solar system or constellation tours, what's visible in the current night sky, and astronomy in the news.
